**Prognostic importance of adjuvant chemotherapy in the presence of cardiovascular disease.** There is currently a worldwide shortage of RCT data on the benefits and harms of adjuvant chemotherapy in specific subsets of women with early-stage breast cancer, including those who are older or have comorbid cardiovascular disease (CVD). In the absence of RCT data, evidence from observational data can be used to make informed clinical decisions, with the caveat that such evidence is likely to be less robust than that obtained from RCTs. This review aims to synthesise and critically appraise the literature relating to the risks and benefits of adjuvant chemotherapy in patients with early-stage breast cancer and comorbid CVD. PubMed and EMBASE databases were searched from inception until September 2017 for studies that reported outcomes of breast cancer patients with CVD. We identified 24 eligible studies. In general, the evidence on the outcomes of chemotherapy in patients with comorbid CVD is limited. Additionally, the evidence for different adjuvant chemotherapy regimens in patients with CVD is limited, with evidence being available from only one non-randomised trial. The available evidence suggests that chemotherapy may be associated with significant risks for patients with CVD, particularly cardiovascular events, although the evidence is conflicting for the risk of haemorrhage. In the absence of well-designed RCTs, observational data remain an important source of information to guide clinical decision making.
