A: You are posting a screenshot of a motherboard, which is not a driver. This is an example of a driver (n15235-audio.inf). You have a motherboard with an on-board audio chip (n15235-audio.inf). I do not know what the chip is, but it has specific audio files that help the system know what the speakers are, what the audio channels are, etc. A motherboard is just a piece of plastic that connects a CPU, RAM, PSU, and video card. The drivers are for the video card. Q: Why does the Digg button go inactive when I click on it? Does anyone know what's up with the Digg button on the end of questions that are submitted? It's inactive, but if you click on it it becomes active and then inactive again when you try to click it. I tried to look through my profile settings for something relating to Digg and couldn't find anything. Does anyone have a clue as to why this is happening and what I can do about it? A: It's not Digg, it's the method that Stack Exchange uses for referring users to Digg. There's a button on each post asking a user to 'submit', then the button's color changes to blue (as in Digg). When you click on the button, it will take you to a link to Digg, so the button goes back to inactive (as in Digg). I'm not really sure why, but I've seen this on some questions, and on some I've been able to submit myself.
