When selecting chars, you can either single-click them to select, or select by typing the first few characters of the character you want to select. - View Paragraph Separators: WhiteSpace Crack Free Download plugin provides the ability to view paragraph separators including a blank line, line space and tabulator. - View Trailing White Spaces: You can view trailing white spaces, delete them and highlight them. - Select Trailing White Spaces: WhiteSpace plugin allows you to view and highlight trailing spaces. You can select line spaces and tabs by typing the first few characters. Does anyone know a way to modify the plugin so it does not "reset" (kinda) when a new file is loaded? I use it to automatically format a text file and load it back into jedit but when I edit it and save, it reloads (but not in the same place I saved) and the whitespace formatting is gone. very much for developing this! You'll have to find a way to get it to work properly when opening/saving multiple files. There are tons of ways to create/load multiple files, you can just use a basic timer to run a script every N seconds or just set up a function to run as you save/exit the editor. It would take a bit of work to make it happen but I'm sure it would be a popular plugin for editing more than one file in jEdit. How do I use this on windows? I have tried to use it but it shows me the "Selected Characters" page and then it disappears. I am using Windows 7 Ultimate x64 and have no problems with PEFix. I would love to use this plugin on windows as well. The problem is that only on windows it does not let me view whitespace to automatically highlight them. No need for a new version just for windows. I'm running it on windows from source and it works perfectly. But you may be able to use the pro version to see and edit invisible chars. If not, keep using PEFix to do it manually. Thanks for the quick reply. I used PEFix but it was having problems with the current file, not the current project. I

WhiteSpace automatically highlights the following:  
White Space: Tab Space: Left Tab Space: Right Tab Space: Horizontal Space: Vertical Space: Computer Space: Using WhiteSpace is easy. Add it to jEdit by selecting Tools/Plugins/Add. WhiteSpace can also be downloaded from The following example shows WhiteSpace highlighting the tab character. First, make sure you set the HighlightSelectionProperties to highlight invisible characters. You can also highlight all of the invisible characters at once by selecting the check box for HighlightInvisibleCharacters. Check the check boxes for the characters you want WhiteSpace to highlight (invisible characters are indicated by white, enclosed ellipsis). By default, only tabs and vertical spaces are highlighted. On the Options side, set the foreground and background colors to whatever you like (you can set foreground and background to the same color if you want). To set the Line Numbers In the Line Numbers side, you can set the spacing between the line numbers and the lines by setting LineNumbersSpacing, LineNumberLength and LineNumberWidth. The LineNumbersSpacing sets the spacing between the line numbers and the line numbers, and LineNumberWidth sets the line numbers

width. `LineNumberLength` sets the length of the line numbers. The default values of `LineNumbersSpacing` and `LineNumberWidth` is zero (nothing is between the line number and the line) and 20 pixels (20 pixels width for the line number). In the Details side, you can set whether to show the line number if the line is in the editable region or the line is in the editable region.

What is the best editor for programming? You should use a text editor that supports syntax highlighting, easy directory navigation and a lot of

other features. I use Vim most of the time. There is a lot of help available if you have any problems at the Vim documentation. Is there a GUI version? Yes, there is a version with a graphical user interface but it is not open source, and only available from the official website. Is there an offline version? The current version of the plugin can be installed from the official website. If your browser supports websockets, you can also install the plugin from the plugin's documentation pages. Frequently Asked Questions Do you need to download the plugin? No. The plugin is activated on the server. You can see the feature description and screenshots above. You can download the plugin's source code at the official website. Can I install plugins on Windows? Yes. If you want to install plugins using the command line, you need to use the `-install` option. I have downloaded the plugin source code and the sample plugins, how to install the plugin? You need to unzip the zip file and put the `plugins/features` directory into the `plugins` directory.
